- Exam Part A: simple multiple-choice, 1 attempt with a single try at each question. 70% pass mark.
- Exam Part B: application multiple-choice, 1 attempt with 3 tries at each question. 100% pass mark.
- Interactive Simulation assessment
  - Online simulation designed to mimic a real-life workplace situation testing the skills and knowledge covered by the Skills Unit.
  - Can be completed any time in the week following your Exam and can be attempted an unlimited number of times.
  - You must successfully navigate the simulation through to completion to pass.
- All Assessments are open book.
- If the student is unsuccessful in one or both components of their assessment, student needs to re-enrol in a study period that commences within 6 months from the initial study period's result release date.
